to pursue just immigration reform that seeks full inclusion for immigrants in our society.




Remembering Eve Bach (7/18/41 - 3/1/10)

A long-time EBHO member and Board member for six years, Eve Bach was a remarkable advocate for the equitable and sustainable development of affordable housing. She brought 30+ years of experience as a City and regional planner, economist, and community activist to a host of EBHO campaigns. As the Economics & Planning Director for Arc Ecology, she worked thousands of hours reviewing and analyzing complex planning documents, drafting comments, providing community education, and developing creative and insightful affordable housing strategies with groups throughout the Bay Area. A few examples with EBHO include Housing Element campaigns to create suitable sites, adequate zoning, and strong affordable housing programs, and the Concord Naval Weapons Station campaign to ensure permanent affordable housing, access to open space and parks, and family-supporting jobs. With Renewed Hope in Alameda, she fought for affordable housing at the Alameda Naval Air Station. Beyond her incomparable skills, we will long remember Eve's integrity, forthrightness, infectious giggle, and unwavering commitment to achieving EBHO's goals. As our dear friend and colleague, we deeply miss her.

She is survived by her husband of 40 years, Gale, her daughter, Nadira, her grandson, Nigel, and other family members.
